

HEADING UP TO ASHLAND

to join the tour: It's a beautiful drive, about 5.5 hours from Madison, add another hour from Milwaukee, about 2 more from the Chicago area. We'll share some personal favorite optional stops (think cheese, of course, and sausage, maybe a few attractions, as well as select eateries, big plastic animals, and other neat "stuff".) All of these are optional diversions we have enjoyed over the years on many drives to Ashland and the Apostles. They take anywhere from a few minutes to whatever time you care to spend – now or on future drives.

THURSDAY AUG. 17 – THE TOPLESS RENDEZVOUS BEGINS!

Ashland, Wisconsin. Once a major port for shipping iron ore, today it hosts thousands of travelers who enjoy its hotels, breweries, and restaurants, and tour its amazing collection of painted murals. One not well-kept secret is that the refreshing artesian water you can drink here (and carry home in your own bottles) is believed by many local residents to promote good health and a strong body. Check in to your hotel and then register at the AmercInn Headquarters overlooking Lake Superior. Tonight the legendary OpenAir Welcome Buffet Banquet, Driver's Meeting, and the Sacred Navigator's Oath will be here with a cash bar starting at 6 PM and the feast beginning at 7PM. Meet great touring friends as the adventure begins!

FRIDAY AUG. 18 - SHOW ME THE ISLANDS!

Up early, breakfast on your own, We will grid the cars a short drive from the Americann and send you off one by one with turn-by-turn instructions for a full day of driving along parts of the Lake Superior National Scenic Byway, stopping at select checkpoints along the way, cruising some of the awesome forested back roads and pioneer trails that take us to "The Greatest Little Town in the Midwest!" That's Bayfield, so named by the Chicago Tribune travel scribes a few years ago. (It's even better today!) Bayfield is brimming with galleries, bookstores, shops, outfitters and dining options. It is the western port for the Madeline Island Ferry to LaPointe. We'll arrange for you to ride (as a passenger, round-trip) to the historic Island and send you to a few special check points, shops, and a one-of-a-kind northern Tiki-Bar that's on the list of the "best bars in the world." If you want to take your car and motor around the Island, you may do so at the current round-trip ferry rate (Vehicle \$29-\$43), - you'll have RT passenger tickets included in your OAC registration. Return to Bayfield and the area for further exploring or cruising. Dinner is on your own tonight - this is a great opportunity to get a group together to share road stories and meet new -and old - friends. OAC will work with local restaurants in Bayfield, Washburn, Ashland, and the Bad River Casino to offer specials to our touring participants.

SATURDAY AUG. 19 - TOPLESS CONCOURS AND BACK TO THE GARDEN!

Another great day ahead! Start early - (7AM parking the cars) as our tour enjoys a True North Welcome in Ashland as we stage our famous Topless Concours on the Ashland Main Street. The public is invited to stroll in to our beauties, from 8-10 AM. You'll have a ballot to vote for your favorites! At 10AM we will have the fabled "OAC LeMans-style start" giving each car their day's driving route options to see even more of Apostle Islands Country and the Lake Superior National Scenic Byway. You'll visit charming seaside communities, stop at special checkpoints, cruise the "Fruit Loop" through the orchards in the Bayfield Hills, and discover more gems along "the Big Lake." Dinner is on your own tonight. We gather at the top of Mount Ashwabay at the award-winning "Carnegie Hall of Tent Shows," Big Top Chautauqua (BTC). Tonight we'll be treated to a rockin' special 7:30PM performance arranged for OpenAir Classic XVII. "Back to the Garden" is a celebration of the music of Woodstock The Big Top venue has great pub fare, brews and food available with picnic tables in the area for pre-show dining, BTC is about 15 minutes south from Bayfield if you plan to dine in town. After the concert, cruise back to Ashland under a sky studded with twinkling stars, the Milky Way, and possibly (fingers crossed) a magical appearance of the Aurora Borealis which has been very active this year.

In 2022 the Peroutkas left OAC to have more time for personal travel and family. Knowles children, Alex and Carleigh have grown up with the OAC and are often contributors. Alex and his fiancee Samantha Wagner have now joined Gary and Mae to plan and staff the tour. Previous participants Felix and Mary Beth Savino also will assist with tour operations. Other members also graciously pitch-in to help with registration and tour logistics. The OAC Directors team selects destinations & hotels, sets routes, directs the tours and oversees promotions & operations. We are honored to share the road and this exhilarating adventure with you. It's our mission and high honor to make these four days your finest, most enjoyable, and most memorable getaway of the summer!















OAC RULES OF THE ROAD 2023

- 1. ELIGIBILITY: Welcome driving enthusiasts! The OpenAir Classic (OAC) is open to any street-legal convertible, T-Top, or open-top Jeep type vehicle.
- **2. OBJECTIVES:** Have fun, drive great roads, meet friendly people, safely.
- 3. MEMBER'S REGISTRATION: Members may send entries by US Postal Service beginning June 12, 2023. Postmarks before June 12 will be cycled to the end of the members' line for grid position numbers. Only OAC Members will be registered for the first 200+ grid positions through June 27.
- **4. NON-MEMBERS REGISTRATION:** Non-members may apply starting June 27, 2023 for open or waiting list grid positions that may open. NO FAXES, EMAIL OR DELIVERY SERVICE ENTRIES. Use U.S. Postal Service only.
- 5. REGISTRATION DEADLINES: Final deadline for postmarked entry is July 20, 2023, however the event is likely to be sold out much earlier. Don't delay!

WAITING LIST: Will be maintained for entries over 200+. In past years we have filled up to 5 from the waiting list.

- **6. OAC GRID LIMITS:** Directors reserve the right to adjust registration limit as they deem appropriate and necessary.
- 7. REGISTRATION IS NON-TRANSFERRABLE. NO WALK-UP REGISTRATIONS ALLOWED.
- 8. CONFIRMATIONS will be sent by email or US Mail BY AUGUST 4 indicating that your registration has been received and that you are registered. If you have not received a confirmation by Aug. 4, please email us at

- info@openairtours.com. (Be sure info@openairtours.com is on your "friends" "ok" or "not-spam" e-mail list so our mail arrives promptly to your in-box!)
- **9.DIRECTORS** reserve all rights to adjust and/or alter any parts of these tours to enhance the safety of participants and to ensure the enjoyment of all. These decisions are not subject to any appeal.
- 10. OAC TOPS DOWN START: An OAC tradition is to have a "tops down" start where all participants "drop their tops" together. Starting order will be determined by directors.
- 11. NON-COMPETITIVE: This is a tour for fun! It is not a rally or race. The only requirement will be to stop at designated check points if you want to be eligible to win prizes. Check points will be open to give everyone a reasonable time to visit and pass through. You only need arrive at the end destination by the time noted. Our objective is to ensure that everyone has a fun, safe and enjoyable tour.
- 12. ROAD SERVICE: All mechanical service and repairs are your responsibility. Though our participants are known for being helpful, be prepared to deal with breakdowns that may occur. Many people choose to join auto clubs or buy road service insurance. Please review your options and be prepared.
- 13. MEALS AND ACCOMMODATIONS: Participants are responsible for making their own arrangements for meals (except as noted in itinerary) and accommodations. The Headquarter and Official Hotels have been selected as a convenience for participants. Ask for OAC room

- block for special tour rate. Always call at least 10 days before arrival to CONFIRM YOUR ROOM! Also: Special Wednesday or Sunday rates are available for those who want to arrive early or stay an extra night.
- 14. REGISTRATION FEES & BENEFITS: Registration fees are \$389.00 for car, driver and a navigator. Extra passengers 6 years and over are \$90 per person. OAC Members receive a \$10.00 discount one time per membership-year as noted on entry form. NOTE: Payment accepted by CHECK ONLY.
- 15. TOUR ROUTES, materials and events are intended for the use and enjoyment of officially registered OAC participants only. All copy, reproduction, and distribution rights are reserved by OAC. Any copying or sharing of routes or materials or facilitating entry into events by non-participants is prohibited. Please discuss any "guests" or extenuating circumstances with Directors.
- 16. PRIZES: Each vehicle will have one entry in the Grand Prize Drawing (if it has participated all four days' events). Other drawings will be open to all drivers and those passengers that have purchased an official game card. Member drawings are open to all participating members in good standing. Organizers reserve the right to limit prizes to one major prize per person per day.
- 17. REFUNDS: 50% of paid reg. fees if notice is received by 7/2/23; 25% from 7/3/23-7/27/23 and NONE THEREAFTER. You must receive a cancellation number from OAC staff to qualify for a refund. Refunds paid after the tour is complete.
